1.1 4th meeting in Poland

Topics: Maths and Natural Science

3 students per country max because of organisational reasons

Schedule:

- Tuesday, 25th September 2012: arrival in Jastrzębie Zdrój; program starts Wednesday morning.
- Friday, 28th September 2012: program ends about 12 o'clock

Task:

- prepare logical mathematical game for 14 -19 years old students; game is more important than mathematical aspect
- logo competition: each country presents its best Comenius logo(s)
- each country presents its school's environment (landscape, region, town, food)
- European hymn: translate 1st stanza into your mother tongue and e-mail to Joanna julia.bugaj@gmail.com until September 1st
- bring results of your picture dictionary chapter *useful plants*

2. Summary of group works

2.1 Self-evaluation

- discussion about the procedure of the teachers' questionnaire

Task: All teams are asked to let the teachers of their schools fill in the teacher-questionnaire and to **summarize and send the results to Piia until 31st May 2012.**

- presentation of different means of self-evaluation in P.E. and Art (concepts by Kati and Arto from Finland and Birgit from German team)

Task: collect **examples** of different means of self-evaluation that you can use in your lessons. Send examples to Joanna until **June 17th**

2.2. Picture dictionaries

- The teams present their results.
- Every country prepares seven picture dictionaries of which every country will get one at the last meeting.

Task: The section "useful plants" must be ready at the Poland-Meeting. If there are results for the other chapters already, these can be presented as well.

3. Pupil's and teacher's activities

- Tuesday:
 - Great Opening of the Art Exhibition and Comenius-Meeting in Paimio town hall (speech by headmaster, dance performance, buffet, exhibition)
 - the parade "Garden on Wheels" took place. Starting from the local school, the parade went through the village; the video-documentation of the parade was made by Manuel
 - "Seven Trees" -event: participants of all countries planted typical trees
- Wednesday:
 - Welcoming party at town hall (speech in Finish and English, music with "kantele" (Finish national instrument), dance show, Anthem of Europe)
 - Teachers and students attend different classes
 - Students participate in sports event: students from each country present a game which is then played by everybody
 - Teachers listen to presentation about the Finnish school system and plan the project work
 - Cooking and Art-events for students
- Thursday:
 - Students and teachers visit Turku cathedral and "Aboa Vetus"- museum
 - Lunch on Rudolfina-boat
 - Teachers: guided tour at Paimio sanatorium designed by Alvar Aalto
- Friday:
 - Students present their school in school auditorium
 - Teachers' seminar on self-evaluation
